Anness Trounces Tisdel in 3rd Quarter Fundraising

Barb Anness for State Rep Campaign Reports FIVE Times the Contributions than Competitor

Rochester Hills, MI (October 25, 2020) -- The Barb Anness for State Representative campaign has **outraised** opponent Mark Tisdel by an extraordinary \$223,360.11. Anness reports a total 3rd quarter haul of \$282,790.11, compared to Tisdel's \$59,430 in contributions. Anness had 22,845 unique contributions versus a meager 83 unique contributors from the Tisdel campaign. Anness contributions are **five times more than her opponent**.

"We've created an amazing grassroots campaign, and the enthusiasm is spreading for change in this district," said Barb Anness. "Residents want a candidate who represents their values; strong education, healthcare, support for families and small businesses throughout the pandemic, and a steward for our environment."

The overwhelming disparity was noted Friday evening by Anness campaign manager Ethan Petzold. "These kinds of numbers show widespread community support for Barb Anness, and people in Greater Rochester know what the stakes are," he said. "Our campaign put together an incredible grassroots effort, where every average contribution of \$22 is enthusiastically welcomed."

Recently, Governor Whitmer and Lieutenant Governor Gilchrist have joined the efforts along with state senators and representatives. "The stakes in this campaign for THIS district could not be higher," shared Anness. "We know the future of our state legislature hangs in the balance, so every vote counts and can make the difference for a future Michigan that takes care of its' citizens."
